I would like to thank the Anglian Boxer Club for inviting me to judge bitches at their championship show. I thoroughly enjoyed myself and I would like to thank my steward Trevor Welch for making my judging experience so easy. Overall I was impressed with the bitches under me. I felt that some of them needed harder muscular condition. Please remember this is a working dog and hence needs to be kept in good muscular condition. Overall I found heads less wrinkled than the last time I judged which is a positive but I would like to see an improvement in eye size and shape. I found a few mouths that were not within the standard as one is not expected to check the bite and find the tongue involved. On reflection the breed is in good shape in my opinion.

BABY PUPPY 4

Fay-Smith's Lorrosa My Type On Paper. Br/Wh 5 month old and a very exciting puppy which was full of character. Tall and elegant with all angles correct, nice and short and moved around the ring well for one so young. A well balanced head which is developing correctly.

McCarthy & Gething's Lorrosa My Heads Been Turned to Jeddhi Another lovely youngster who I see is litter mate to the above. Once again a well balanced with a lovely balanced head. Just preferred eye shape of 1. Moved around with enthusiasm and these are two promising pups which I will watch with interest

1) Spencer's Ashrona Wildest Dreams 8 year old girl in excellent condition. Lovely square outline with good reach of neck flowing into correctly angled shoulders. Well balanced head with good rise of skull and lovely eye shape. Moved around the ring with enthusiasm and obviously was enjoying her day out. Best veteran in show

2) Godwin's Ch Tyegarh Negroni Approaching nine year old who was in excellent condition. Good square outline with once again good reach of neck. Well balanced head with good square muzzle. Moved well.

MINOR PUPPY 2

1) Brown & Hutchings's Winuwuk Ghostly Affair. Exciting young lady with a lovely square outline. Well balanced head with good square muzzle with good filling under the eyes. Good eye shape and excellent mouth. Well presented and handled and moved with enthusiasm.

2) Seeney's Maranseen Serendipity Another youngster with a lovely temperament. Well angled front with good reach of neck. Lovely expression with well balanced head. Good mouth. Moved with enthusiasm

PUPPY BITCH 2

Drinkwater's Sulez Smashedit Tall upstanding bitch who just shouted boxer to me. Lovely balanced head with good black mask, good and excellent eye shape. Lovely reach of neck flowing into good front angulation. Good bone and tight feet. Excellent quarters which moved her steadily around. In agreement with our co judge Best puppy in Show.

Edison's Lanfrese Agino at Vizage. Another exciting bitch to watch in the future but was not as cooperative with her handler on the day. Well balanced head with good mouth and lip placement. Good square outline and well muscled.

JUNIOR BITCH 1

McCarthy & Gething's Jeddhi Ring of Fire. A young lady who I am sure will hit the high spots. Standing alone but would have won many of the classes today. Just needs to mature to complete the true picture. Well muscled and in excellent condition. Lovely reach of neck flowing into well angled front. Well barrelled chest with correct depth. Moved well and well handled.

YEARLING BITCH 6 (2 Abs)

Hare's Jimbren Queen of Tarts Another bitch who will trouble the rest when she is slightly older. A well muscled bitch who is extremely square as required by the standard. Good depth of brisket and lovely forechest. Excellent head with good mouth and correct lip placement. Was a bit lethargic on the move probably due to the heat and could do with losing a few pounds

Payne's Willow Irish Mist A lovely headed bitch with good balance of skull to muzzle. Skull width must not get any broader. Good front and rear angulation and moved well but tended to lose her topline

NOVICE BITCH 6

Huggins Willow Belle Star for Daervlish A lovely square bitch with good front angulation and well muscled and angled rear quarters which propelled her around the ring with ease. Excellent head with good balance of muzzle to skull in the correct ratio. Good mouth and correct chin. Well boned and good feet and evident forechest. Last 4 for CC

Faye-Smith's Lorroza Seniorita Tall bitch with good front angulation and good feet. Head in good proportions with correct lip placement and good mouth. If anything she is a bit too short in back. Moved well

Murfin & Cobbledick's JedhhiSpice it up at Farvalley

GRADUATE BITCH 7 (2 Abs)

Drinkwater's Sulez Teaser Another bitch from this clever breeder. Tall elegant bitch with lovely arch to neck flowing into correctly angled shoulders and good upper arm. Good bone and tight feet. Good level topline and well muscled and angled quarters Good depth of chest and good forechest. Moved well but was more lethargic in the challenge. In the last 4 for CC

Fay-Smith's Lorroza Missy Elliot Well balanced head with correct skull shape and good blocky muzzle. Good chin and mouth. Excellent angulation but a bit loose when moving towards me. Well handled and good firm musculation.

Jones Kevanor Summer Breeze

POST GRADUATE BITCH 8 (3Abs)

Lock's Romanico Bacctu Clarricks Tall elegant bitch with excellent musculation. Lovely neck flowing into correct front angulation. Good bone and tight feet. Good barrelled chest and plenty forechest. Head in correct proportions with good rise of skull. Good mouth and chin. Well handled in the heat and moved with ease around the ring

Elsworth's SugarwoodPatt Pendingto Misstricks. Another well balanced bitch who was in good condition. Lovely front angulation with good bone and tight feet, Well muscled rear end with good angulation. Just preferred head of 1 but good chin and mouth. Handled well and moved with purpose.

LIMIT BITCH 6

Murfin & Cobbledick's Farvalley Milyon Dolla Baby How lovely to see such a lovely red bitch shown in such excellent condition. Lovely reach of neck flowing into good front angulation Good depth of chest and adequate forechest. Good sloping level topline Well muscled and angulated quarters. Good tuck up. Moved well around the ring and well handled . In last 4 for CC.

Spencer's Uptonnds Maid by the Loch at Ashronsha Another good moving bitch who showed with great alertness Lovely neck with short sloping topline. Hind quarters were well angulated which helped her drive around the ring. Good with good mouth and chin. Just preferred head of 1.

Flintoff's Boxania Make Smile

OPEN BITCH 4 (2 Abs)

Payne's Ch/IR CH Willow Sparks will Fly Well this was the star of the show for me today. Shown in good muscular condition with an absolutely classic head When you stand in front of her correctly shape dark eyes just shout boxer at you. Lovely balance of skull to muzzle with a correct chin and good mouth. Long arched neck flowing into well angulated front. Good bone and tight feet. Good depth of chest and correct tuck up. Quarters are well muscled and good turn of stifle. Moved with purpose and very well handled. CC and on referee's decision BIS
Brown & Hutchings CH Winuwuk Silent Witness. A real champion boxer bitch from two clever breeders. Head shape and balance is completely correct good rise of skull with correct eye shape. Lovely length of neck flowing into slightly sloping topline. Good quarters. Good tuck up. Moved effortlessly around the ring and expertly handled in the heat. RCC
